Recent or upcoming graduates who have Macau ID and have recently completed bachelor's degree or higher in Macau or overseas are welcome to apply. This program lasts approximately 16 months including 11 month on-the-job and classroom training in Las Vegas and 5 month management training in Macau.

During their 11 month on-the-job training program in Las Vegas, Management Associates will rotate through departments within their division of interest. Associates will engage in the community through volunteer activities, learn best practices and operational strategies from top leaders each month in a classroom series we call "Division Leader Series", and spend time networking with top leaders at each of our properties in a learning series called "Resort Knowledge Days". On top of being developed into a leader within our organization, Associates will learn all roles and responsibilities from line-level to management over to build a solid career foundation.
