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**Prof. Glenn MCCARTNEY**, Associate Dean (Curriculum and Teaching) and Associate Professor in Integrated Resort and Tourism Management shared his opinion on Macao's tourism and casino recovery entitled "The tourists wanted in Macau" at Plataforma Media on 6 January 2023.

#### Article sharing:

"We have witnessed around the world the phenomenon of 'accumulated demand', where airports and other tourism infrastructures are overloaded and have difficulties in dealing with the increase in the number of visitors. What we can see in the Mainland and in Hong Kong is that there is this demand for Macau, but it has not yet materialized because we are dealing with the consequences of the spread of the virus in the community. The travel agencies already indicate a great interest from travelers from Mainland China. So we know it will happen, we just don't know when. We look ahead to the Chinese New Year and we know that we will have to deal with that demand, although right now we are looking into a crystal ball. I believe the promotion roadshows that the local authorities and the dealers have done on the mainland will be important for this new stage," he adds.

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6 PROF. HENRY LEI WAS INVITED TO SHARE HIS OPINION ON MACAO INFLATION RATE "十一月通脹按年升0.76%" BY MACAO DAILY

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**Prof. Henry LEI (李振國教授)**, Associate Head of Department of Finance and Business Economics and Assistant Professor in Business Economics, was invited to share his opinion on Macao inflation rate 十一月通脹按年升0.76%" by Macao Daily on 24 December 2022.

Article sharing:

2023年上半物價仍穩

澳門大學工商管理學院金融及商業經濟系助理教授李振國表示,觀乎2022年11月通脹 數據,升幅較數個月前收窄,近期國際油價、航運成本回調,有助減輕物價上升壓力, 紓緩居民生活壓力。展望未來通脹走勢,關注兩方面。一、國際油價:由於能源價格在 通脹數據中佔比重要,若油價平穩、下跌,均可緩解通脹;二、本地經濟:隨着開放步 伐穩步推動,經濟復甦有望加速,假設經濟反彈,旅客增加,企業可提供的折扣優惠減 少,或將刺激物價上升。2022年經濟表現處於相對低的水平,基數較低,升幅會較為 明顯。

他提到,從經濟學角度,通脹勝於通縮,這反映經濟步入正軌,企業業務在恢復,只要 是溫和通脹,並非壞事。預料2023年上半年因復甦需要過程,物價料維持穩定,但 2023年通脹升幅則有機會高於2022年。
