* Students can test out of the Chinese and/or Portuguese language course(s) if they obtain certain qualifications and should enroll course as follows:

- Test out **EITHER** Chinese Language Course **OR** Portuguese Language Course: One 3-credit free elective in the first semester of first year of study
- Test out **NEITHER** Chinese Language Course **NOR** Portuguese Language Course: CHLL1000 **OR** PORT1000 in the first semester of first year of study

** Students can test out of some or all of the 3 English language courses but still are required to take English courses should enroll course as follow:

- Placement level "IE1": EELC1001 + EELC1002 + EELC1003
- Placement level "IE2": EELC1002 + EELC1003 + One 3-credit free elective course
- Placement level "AE": EELC1003 + Two 3-credit free elective courses
- None of the above: Three 3-credit free elective courses

*** Students can test out of the information technology course should enroll course as follow:

- Did **NOT** test out information technology course: CISC1000 in the second semester of first year of study
- Test out information technology course: One 3-credit free elective in the second semester of first year of study

**** CPED1003 consists of 2 components: Online Lectures, plus Communication and Leadership Activities.
