**A) Year 4 and Graduating Students must do the Self-Graduation Check before pre-enrollment and course add/drop.**

Please download the study plan in FBA Homepage and perform the relative checking from time to time (<https://fba.um.edu.mo/students/study-plans/>). Please ensure you have taken **all required courses** for graduation in your last year of study.

If you have **NOT** taken and passed all required courses in your curriculum, you will **NOT** be able to graduate. In addition, a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 is required for graduation.

**B) Quotas for compulsory courses and major/required electives**

Please check your study plan at the FBA homepage (<https://fba.um.edu.mo/students/study-plans/>) before pre-enrollment and course add/drop to ensure you have enrolled in the correct courses. **Please make sure you have enrolled into all your compulsory courses and major/required electives.**

**C) Study load**

**NO FBA STUDENT WILL BE ALLOWED TO TAKE EIGHT 3-CREDIT COURSES.**

**D) Course/Major information**

**ACCOUNTING (ACCT) COURSES / MAJOR:**

1. ACCT2000 Management Accounting I and ACCT2002 Principles of Managerial Accounting are incompatible. Only 3 credit units will be awarded if students complete the said two courses. ACCT2002 has been phased out since academic year 2018/2019, students who fail to take ACCT2002 will need to take ACCT2000 instead.
2. The pre-requisite requirements of courses below are revised starting from academic year 2017/2018.

- ACCT3006/3007 Internship for Accounting Function I/II, which carry 1.50 credit units each course, are paired required electives for ACC17-PAC17, ACC19 and ACC21 students (B7 and after intakes). These courses **CAN** be counted as free electives for B6 and before intakes. Students intend to take these courses should submit the completed “Internship Acceptance Form” on semester basis and obtain approval from the course instructor concerned before enrollment. Students **should drop this course during the course add/drop period if they are UNABLE to find any internship** successfully.
- Graduates of the Bachelor of Science in Accounting (ACC) programme are awarded numbers of paper exemptions by some international professional accountancy bodies, provided that the corresponding UM courses are completed. Please refer to FBA webpage for details (<https://fba.um.edu.mo/programmes/bachelor/bscacc/>).
- Students should follow the study plan in accordance with their major and intake. **NOT all ACCT courses are offered every semester**. If students do not take courses in the right sequence, they may **NOT** graduate on time. For the study plans, please refer to the FBA homepage (<https://fba.um.edu.mo/students/study-plans/>).



### BUSINESS ECONOMICS (BECO) COURSES / MAJOR:

1. Students are **NOT** allowed to take BECO1000 Principles of Microeconomics and BECO1001 Principles of Macroeconomics at the same time.
2. Students **MUST** take BECO1000 Principles of Microeconomics **before** they can take BECO1001 Principles of Macroeconomics.
3. BECO3006 Money and Banking is for Year 3 and Year 4 students only, and **NO** exchange student is allowed to take this course.
4. BECO3011 Financial Econometrics is for Year 3 and Year 4 FNC and FNE students only, and **NO** exchange student is allowed to take this course.
5. BECO4004 Applied Econometrics is for BEC and BEC-SEC students only, and **NO** exchange student is allowed to take this course.
6. BECO4005 Applied Economics for Leisure Industries for BEC and BEC-SEC students only, and **NO** exchange student is allowed to take this course.
7. BECO4014 International Banking is for FNC, FNE, BEC and BEC-SEC students only, and **NO** exchange student is allowed to take this course.
8. **IMPORTANT:** If a course is offered in the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester, normally it will **NOT** be offered in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of next academic year anymore with the exception of BECO1000 and BECO1001. A course will **NOT** be re-offered in the next semester even if students need the course to graduate.
9. BEC and BEC-SEC students should carefully perform graduation check before pre-enrollment and course add/drop period to ensure that you are able to complete all the required courses for graduation.

### FINANCE (FINC) COURSES / MAJOR:

1. Courses in the 1<sup>st</sup> column of the table below are equivalent to courses in the 2<sup>nd</sup> column correspondingly. Therefore, only 3 units of credit will be granted if students complete equivalent courses.

2. Courses from old programme (A8 and before intakes) had not been offered since academic year 2012/2013. 3. FINC2000 Financial Management is **NOT** for FNC16, FNC17 and FNC20 students (B6 and after intakes), they should take FINC2003 Corporate Finance instead.
4. ***FINC3003 Financial Markets and Institutions is for Year 3 & 4 FNC and FNE students only.***
5. FINC4011 Applied Financial Project is a two-semester course for FNC students only. Year-4 students should ensure that you have enrolled this course at the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of academic year 2019/2020. If you have not taken the course in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester, your graduation will be delayed.
6. FINC4014 Exotic Options and Structured Products is for Year 4 FNC and FNE students only.
7. Students should carefully perform graduation check before pre-enrollment and course add/drop period to ensure that you are able to complete all the required courses for gradation.
8. Students who would like to go on overseas exchange programme should go in their 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> year of study. You **MUST** stay in UM to complete the one-year applied research project (i.e. FINC4011 Applied Financial Project) in your 4<sup>th</sup> year of study.
9. **IMPORTANT:** If a course is offered in the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester, normally it will **NOT** be offered in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of the next academic year. A course will **NOT** be re-offered in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of the next academic year even if students need the course to graduate.



### INTERNATIONAL INTEGRATED RESORT MANAGEMENT (IRTM) COURSES / MAJOR:

1. Prefix “IIRM” will be updated to “IRTM” for all IIRM courses starting from academic year 2019/2020. Courses with prefixes “IIRM” and “IRTM” are equivalent. For example, IRTM1000 is equivalent to IIRM1000.
2. PSYC1000 Introduction to Psychology is a compulsory course for IIR17 students (B7, B8 and part of B9 intakes). IIR17 students are **NOT** allowed to take GESB1010 Psychology of Everyday Life as General Education (GE) course or free elective (FE); In addition, if the students have already completed PSYC1000, they are **NOT** allowed to take GESB1010 as GE or FE course.
3. IIR students (**B9 intakes**) MUST enroll the courses according to the corresponding study plan (**IIR17 – original curriculum or IIR20 – 2020/2021 curriculum**). Please refer to related study plans (<https://fba.um.edu.mo/students/study-plans/>) for details.
4. **IIR20 students** MUST enroll **ONE** RE course from “Common Required Electives List” and **ONE** RE course from “Convention & Hospitality Management Required Electives List” (for CHM20) OR “Gaming Management Required Electives List” (for GMM20). Please refer to study plans (<https://fba.um.edu.mo/students/study-plans/>) for details.
5. IRTM2001 Psychology of Gambling and IRTM3002 Convention and Exhibition Management will be offered in the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of academic year 2021/2022. Gaming Management (GMM) students and Convention & Hospitality Management (CHM) students shall enroll in the corresponding courses according to their respective study plans.
6. IRTM4002 Global Issues in Resort and Gaming Management will be offered for final year students in the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of academic year 2021/2022.
7. HGM11 students (B3 to B6 intakes) need to take **non-FBA electives** to fulfil the graduation requirement. Please refer to related study plans (<https://fba.um.edu.mo/students/study-plans/>) for details.

### INFORMATION SYSTEMS AND OPERATIONS MANAGEMENT (ISOM) COURSES:

1. QMDS102 Applied Calculus has phased out; HGM11-GMM11 students (B1 to B6 intakes) who fail to take QMDS102 will need to take ISOM1004 Applied Calculus instead.
2. ISOM2004 will **NOT** be offered in the near future, HGM11-GMM11 students (B1 to B6 intakes) who fail to take ISOM2004 will need to take ISOM2002 instead.
3. ISOM4003 Implementation of Accounting Information Systems is a final year level course. Students who do not have knowledge of database management, networking and communication, as well as systems analysis and design are **NOT** recommended to take this course.
4. ISOM2000 Business Programming and ISOM3029 Computer Programming Using C++ are equivalent courses. ISOM2000 has been phased out since academic year 2019/2020; students who fail to take ISOM2000 will need to take ISOM3029 instead.
5. ISOM4000 Spreadsheets and Decision Modeling is substituted by ISOM3035 Operations Management.
6. ISOM3013 Advanced Business Programming is substituted by ISOM3028 Advanced Computer Programming.

1. MGMT1000 Principles of Management is offered to GBS20 students (C1 intake), and all retaking students only.

- In order not to delay your graduation, students should (a) finish all major compulsory courses by the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of the fourth year of study; and (b) follow the study plan in FBA homepage by taking the major electives in each semester.

- ◆ In order to satisfy the GE requirement, **students admitted between academic years 2011/2012 and 2016/2017 (B1 to B6 intakes)** are required to take **TWO** courses from **Area 1** and **ONE** course from **EACH of Area 2 to 13**. Additional GE course(s) taken will **ONLY** be counted as free elective(s). For further details, please refer to the GE course list of your own intake (<https://fba.um.edu.mo/students/study-plans/>).
- ◆ FBA students (B1 to B6 intakes) and IIR17 students (B7 and B8 intakes) are required to take PSYC1000 Introduction to Psychology. These students are **NOT** allowed to take GESB1010 Psychology of Everyday Life to fulfil either the GE or FE requirement.

#### DISTRIBUTION/DIVERSITY (DE) COURSES:

- ◆ Students **admitted between academic years 2011/2012 and 2016/2017 (B1 to B6 intakes)** have to take DE courses in order to satisfy their curriculum. The four DE courses should be from four different major programmes/disciplines other than the student's own major programme. For the disciplines of each FBA major programme, you can refer to the FBA website for your reference (<https://fba.um.edu.mo/students/study-plans/>).
- ◆ Please visit the Registry homepage (<https://reg.um.edu.mo/current-students/course-enrolment/generalinfo/>) for course disciplines.
- ◆ Students majoring in ACC11, ACC13-PAC13, ACC13-AIS13, ACC15-PAC15, ACC15-AIS15, FNC11, FNC11-BKG11, FNC11-CFN11, FNC11-FNE11, FNC11-IMT11, FNC16, FNC16-FNE16, GBS11, GBS15, BEC11, BEC15, BEC11-SEC11, BEC15-SEC15, ELB11, FIC11, FIC15, GBM11, HRM11, MKG11 and MKG11-RSM11 (B1 to B6 intakes) are required to take ACCT2003 Business Law as one of their DE courses, thus other course(s) with discipline in "Law" will not be classified as their DE course(s).
- ◆ HGM11-CHM11 students (B1 to B6 intakes) have to take IRTM3014 Hospitality and Tourism Law as one of their DE courses, thus other course(s) with discipline in "Law" will not be classified as their DE course(s).
- ◆ HGM11-GMM11 students (B1 to B6 intakes) should take IRTM3012 Gaming Law and IRTM2001 Psychology of Gambling as their DE courses, thus other course(s) with disciplines in "Law" and "Psychology" will not be classified as their DE course(s).

#### ENGLISH LANGUAGE COURSES:

- ◆ **Students (B7 and after intakes)** are required to take English language courses according to the placement level. **BACHELOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (BBA/GBS):**

- ◆ Students are **HIGHLY RECOMMENDED** to perform the self-graduation check before pre-enrollment and course add/drop so that they can know clearly which courses are missing.
- ◆ GBS15 ,GBS17 and GBS20 students (B5 and after intakes) who have taken either MGMT2001 or ISOM2001 in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester, they should take the remaining one in the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester.
- ◆ In order to graduate, it is **COMPULSORY** for **GBM11, GBM17 and GBM20 students to participate in the outgoing exchange programme for AT LEAST one semester.**
- ◆ ELB11 students (B1 and B2 intake), as well as students from BEC11, BEC11-SEC11, BEC15 and BEC15-SEC15 (B1 to B6 intakes) should be aware that there is a **“Non-FBA course” restriction for some free electives in their study plans.**
