【澳大DBA傑出學員】黃晨:規則的突破與堅守

黃晨,於2023年入讀澳門大學工商管理博士(DBA)學位課程,現任上海吉晨衛生後勤服務管理有限公司董事長。 他是一個典型的上海商人,既擁有上海人堅守規則的一面,同時也像所有成功的商人一般,擅於突破。

破釜沉舟,投身商海

黃晨曾是背著鐵飯碗的高校老師。1988年,從上海科技大學畢業後,便進入上海第二醫科大學工作,過著那個時代 所有人眼裡穩穩當當的日子。改革開放的浪潮在1992年席捲而來,面臨著父母的反對和沒有退路的壓力,他勇敢地 於1993年初辭職下海,迅速創立了以口腔材料研發為主要業務的愛吉醫學。在90年代初的上海,經濟迅速發展,入 職外資企業的誘惑也不斷增加。然而,他堅守自己的夢想,相信創業能帶來更大的成就感和自由度。他帶領團隊不 斷研發創新的口腔材料,堅持質量第一的原則,逐漸獲得市場的認可。隨著時間的推移,愛吉醫學逐漸發展壯大, 成為口腔材料行業的領先企業之一。到90年代末,黃晨已有七年創業經驗,但他開始對口腔材料市場的狹窄感到憂 慮。這時,一個新的機會悄然浮現。當時醫院和大學的後勤保障工作仍未對外開放,導致後勤事務上用工的繁瑣和 低效,成為社會發展的障礙。因此,政府提出了逐步外包醫院和大學的後勤保障工作的政策。黃晨的一位醫療前輩 建議他涉足這個新興行業。於是,在千禧年來臨之際,黃晨創立了吉晨衛生後勤服務管理有限公司。他延續了之前 創業公司愛吉醫學的命名方式,希望將自己的初心帶入這個全新的細分行業。吉晨衛生為全國100餘家三級和二級 醫院提供設備設施運行與維護、保潔、運送、保安、配膳、綠化、導醫、被服、電梯駕駛、病床資訊服務平台等非 診療支援服務。近年來,吉晨衛生獲得了多項殊榮,其中包括"全國就業與社會保障先進民營企業"、"傑出企業社會 責任獎"、"中國物業管理綜合實力全國百強企業"等。黃晨一直堅持做企業首先要做好人,注重實際行動和落地的工 作。他對自己手中的企業和員工投入了20年的心血,並承擔著對醫療後勤服務行業的熱情和對全國百姓民生的責 任。2023年,吉晨品牌下所有公司的總收入已達到18億,年增長率高達30%。黃晨笑著說,馬雲想讓阿里巴巴成為 百年企業,而吉晨也同樣懷抱著這個願景。對於未來,他充滿樂觀,堅信AI的發展也無法取代吉晨,因為醫院後勤 這個行業始終需要人文關懷。





心裡有光,素履以往

作為一個上海人,黃晨的性格特點使他更加謹慎和務實。他自嘲說自己是個"膽子小"的人,不擅於追逐快速的金 錢。這種性格也體現在他的商業理念上。做醫療後勤保障服務,與醫院接軌,這便意味著企業每天與百姓民生打交 道。背靠並服務造福一方百姓的醫院,黃晨堅決承襲著"我們在保障薄利的前提下,不能通過不斷提升對醫院的收費 來賺取利潤"。作為一位宅心仁厚的企業家,他總能透過醫療行業洞察到百姓的需求。所以,黃晨多次強調"公司不 上市",正是因為吉晨不想迎合上市公司10%-15%的高利潤回報率,也不想給醫院與百姓徒增經濟壓力。他一直信奉 著一位寧波前輩的教誨,創業最重要的是衝勁、講感情和有義氣。2003年,抗擊非典,吉晨豪不猶豫走在了抗非第 一線;2020年,新冠疫情肆掠,作為老牌擁有抗擊疫情豐富經驗的後勤保障公司,全公司員工按照上海市衛健委要 求,臨危受命,堅守在一線配合醫護人員,得到了合作醫院、上海市衛健委等部門的高度認可。黃晨還創立了吉晨 扶貧基金會,不忘社會責任與初心,努力承擔社會責任,積極投身于全面決勝小康"精准扶貧"。另外,黃晨還轉變 企業做慈善傳統的資金輸出方式,轉為知識技能培訓、規劃就業專案、分批對接上崗等技術型知識型輸出,實現了 人才可持續發展與企業發展的雙贏新生態。

踏實前行,攀登學術高峰

Abstract

any finance papers present a plot of the cumulative wealth of various investment strategies. wever, it is not entirely clear on how to conduct a statistical analysis on the terminal wealth of ese investment strategies. In this paper, we characterize the statistical properties of the ratio difference of terminal wealths of two investment strategies. The analysis is then extended to udy the statistical properties of the minimum/maximum ratio of terminal wealths when multiple vestment strategies are involved. For an investor with a given investment horizon, he is more treested in holding a portfolio with the highest expected utility based on the terminal wealth at epreferred investment horizon. We provide a statistical test that allows researchers to conduct comparison of expected utility of two competing investment strategies for a given investment rizon. The test is extended to deal with the comparison of multiple investment strategies.
