Students who are working full time but without 2 years of supervisory or managerial experience at the time of application may be able to exempt the internship course upon showing adequate justification to do so to the University. Students who are working full time but without 2 years of supervisory or managerial experience at the time of application may be able to waive from the internship course upon showing adequate justification to do so to the University. All other exempt or waive cases will be subjected to special approval on a case by case basis.
