Please read before Course Add/Drop

A) Year 4 and Graduating Students must do the Self-Graduation Check before pre-enrollment and course add/drop.

Please download the study plan in FBA Homepage and perform the relative checking from time to time (<https://fba.um.edu.mo/students/study-plans/>). Please ensure you have taken **all required courses** for graduation in your last year of study.

If you have NOT taken and passed all required courses in your curriculum, you will NOT be able to graduate. In addition, a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 is required for graduation.

B) Quotas for compulsory courses and major/required electives

Please check your study plan at the FBA homepage (<https://fba.um.edu.mo/students/study-plans/>) before pre-enrollment and course add/drop to ensure you have enrolled in the correct courses. **Please make sure you have enrolled into all your compulsory courses and major/required electives.**

NO FBA STUDENT WILL BE ALLOWED TO TAKE EIGHT 3-CREDIT COURSES.

D) Course/Major information

ACCOUNTING (ACCT) COURSES / MAJOR:

- Due to the new programme implementation, **ACCT3000 Intermediate Accounting II** will be offered in the **2nd semester** of AY2024/2025 and may **NOT** be offered in AY 2025/2026. Students who fulfill pre-requisite requirement (ACCT2001 Intermediate Accounting I) can enroll this course.
- ACCT2004 Intermediate Accounting is **NOT** for ACC17 and ACC19 students (B9 and before intakes). Those students should take ACCT2001 Intermediate Accounting I, ACCT3000 Intermediate Accounting II and ACCT3003 Intermediate Accounting III instead.
- The pre-requisite requirements of courses below are revised starting from academic year 2022/2023.

- ACCT3006/3007 Internship for Accounting Function I/II, which carry 1.50 credit units each course, are paired required electives for ACC17-PAC17, ACC19 and ACC21 students (B7 and after intakes). Students intend to take these courses should submit the completed “Internship Acceptance Form (with job description separately)” on semester basis and obtain approval from the course instructor concerned **before starting the internship/ enrollment**. Students should drop this course during the course add/drop period if they are **UNABLE** to find any internship successfully. - Graduates of the Bachelor of Science in Accounting (ACC) programme are awarded numbers of paper exemptions by some international professional accountancy bodies, provided that the corresponding UM courses are completed. Please refer to FBA webpage for details (<https://fba.um.edu.mo/programmes/bachelor/bscacc/>).
- ACCT3009 Financial Statement Analysis is **NOT** for FIC22 students (C2 and after intakes). FIC22 students should take this course in their 4th year of study.
- Students should follow the study plan in accordance with their major and intake. **NOT all ACCT courses are offered every semester**. If students do not take courses in the right sequence, they may **NOT** graduate on time. **It is recommended to always check and fulfill the prerequisite requirements before enrollment**. For the study plans, please refer to the FBA homepage (<https://fba.um.edu.mo/students/study-plans/>).

BUSINESS ECONOMICS (BECO) COURSES / MAJOR:

- Students are **NOT** allowed to take BECO1000 Principles of Microeconomics and BECO1001 Principles of Macroeconomics at the same time.
- Students **MUST** take BECO1000 Principles of Microeconomics **before** they can take BECO1001 Principles of Macroeconomics.
- BECO3006 Money and Banking is for Year 3 and Year 4 BEC and FNC students only, and **NO** exchange student is allowed to take this course.
- BECO3011 Financial Econometrics is for Year 3 and Year 4 FNC and FNE students only, and **NO** exchange student is allowed to take this course.
- BECO4004 Applied Econometrics is for BEC and BEC-SEC students only, and **NO** exchange student is allowed to take this course.

6. BECO4006 The Economics of Development is for BEC and BEC-SEC students only, and **NO** exchange student is allowed to take this course.
7. **IMPORTANT:** If a course is offered in the 2nd semester, normally it will **NOT** be offered in the 1st semester of next academic year anymore with the exception of BECO1000 and BECO1001. A course will **NOT** be re-offered in the next semester even if students need the course to graduate.
8. BEC and BEC-SEC students should carefully perform graduation check before pre-enrollment and course add/drop period to ensure that you are able to complete all the required courses for graduation.

FINANCE (FINC) COURSES / MAJOR:

1. Courses from old programme (A8 and before intakes) had not been offered since academic year 2012/2013. Students from the old programme can refer to the *List of Equivalent Courses* from Registry Homepage (<https://reg.um.edu.mo/current-students/course-enrolment/generalinfo/>), or check with FBA General Office.
2. FINC2000 Financial Management and FINC2001 Advanced Financial Management are **NOT** for FNC16, FNC17 and FNC20 students (B6 and after intakes), they should take FINC2003 Corporate Finance instead.
3. FINC2003 Corporate Finance is for FNC students only.
4. FINC3002 Theory of Finance is for FIC students and FNC students only.
5. FINC3003 Financial Markets and Institutions is for ACC (C1 Intake and after) and FNC students only.
6. FINC4011 Applied Financial Project is a two-semester course for FNC students only. Year-4 students should ensure that you have enrolled this course at the 1st semester of academic year 2024/2025. If you have not taken the course in the 1st semester, your graduation will be delayed.
7. FINC4014 Exotic Options and Structured Products is for Year 4 FNC and FNE students only.
8. Students should carefully perform graduation check before pre-enrollment and course add/drop period to ensure that you are able to complete all the required courses for graduation.
9. Students who would like to go on overseas exchange programme should go in their 2nd or 3rd year of study. You **MUST** stay in UM to complete the one-year applied research project (i.e. FINC4011 Applied Financial Project) in your 4th year of study.
10. **IMPORTANT:** If a course is offered in the 2nd semester, normally it will **NOT** be offered in the 1st semester of the next academic year. A course will **NOT** be re-offered in the 1st semester of the



next academic year even if students need the course to graduate.

INTERNATIONAL INTEGRATED RESORT MANAGEMENT (IRTM) COURSES / MAJOR:

1. **PSYC1000 Introduction to Psychology** is a compulsory course for IIR17 students (B7, B8 and part of B9 intakes). IIR17 students are **NOT** allowed to take GESB1010 Psychology of Everyday Life as General Education (GE) course or free elective (FE); In addition, if the students have already completed PSYC1000, they are **NOT** allowed to take GESB1010 as GE or FE course.
2. IIR students (**B9 intakes**) **MUST** enroll the courses according to the corresponding study plan (**IIR17 – original curriculum or IIR20 – 2020/2021 curriculum**). Please refer to related study plans (<https://fba.um.edu.mo/students/study-plans/>) for details.
3. **IIR20 students** **MUST** enroll **ONE** RE course from “*Common Required Electives List*” and **ONE** RE course from “*Convention & Hospitality Management Required Electives List*” (for CHM20) OR “*Gaming Management Required Electives List*” (for GMM20). Please refer to study plans (<https://fba.um.edu.mo/students/study-plans/>) for details.
4. IRTM2001 Psychology of Gambling and IRTM3002 Convention and Exhibition Management will be offered in the 2nd semester of academic year 2024/2025. Gaming Management (GMM) students and Convention & Hospitality Management (CHM) students shall enroll in the corresponding courses according to their respective study plans.
5. IRTM4002 Global Issues in Resort and Gaming Management will be offered for final year students in the 2nd semester of academic year 2024/2025.
6. **IRTM4009 Special Topics in Hotel and Resort Management** will be offered in the 1st semester of academic year 2023/2024, and the topic will **focus on corporate social responsibility in integrated resort and tourism management**.

INFORMATION SYSTEMS AND OPERATIONS MANAGEMENT (ISOM) COURSES:

1. ISOM2000 Business Programming and ISOM3029 Computer Programming Using C++ are equivalent courses. ISOM2000 has been phased out since academic year 2019/2020; students who fail to take ISOM2000 will need to take ISOM3029 instead.
2. ISOM3018 Business Data Mining and Visualization is compulsory course for BIA students and they are **NOT** allowed to take ISOM3006 Big Data with Business Applications due to course similarity. Both ISOM3006 and ISOM3018 are **NOT** for FST students to take.
3. ISOM4003 Implementation of Accounting Information Systems is a final year level course. Students who do not have knowledge of database management, networking and communication, as well as systems analysis and design are **NOT** recommended to take this course.
4. The following courses will not be offered in 2023/2024 academic year:

- b. ISOM3006 Big Data with Business Application
- c. ISOM3035 Operations Management

3. MGMT4002 Asian Business is offered to GBM20 students (C1 intake), as well as all retaking students.
4. GBM20 students (C1 intake) are required to take **two** major electives totally in order to fulfill their graduation requirement. Please refer to FBA homepage for more information

- MKTG4000 International Marketing is offered to GBM20 (C1 intake), as well as all retaking students.

- ◆ FBA students (B1 to B6 intakes) and IIR17 students (B7 and B8 intakes) are required to take PSYC1000 Introduction to Psychology. These students are **NOT** allowed to take GESB1010 Psychology of Everyday Life to fulfil either the GE or FE requirement.

DISTRIBUTION/DIVERSITY (DE) COURSES:

- ◆ Students **admitted between academic years 2011/2012 and 2016/2017 (B1 to B6 intakes)** have to take DE courses in order to satisfy their curriculum. The four DE courses should be from four different major programmes/disciplines other than the student's own major programme. For the disciplines of each FBA major programme, you can refer to the FBA website for your reference (<https://fba.um.edu.mo/students/study-plans/>).
- ◆ Please visit the Registry homepage (<https://reg.um.edu.mo/current-students/course-enrolment/generalinfo/>) for course disciplines.
- ◆ Students majoring in ACC11, ACC13-PAC13, ACC13-AIS13, ACC15-PAC15, ACC15-AIS15, FNC11, FNC11-BKG11, FNC11-CFN11, FNC11-FNE11, FNC11-IMT11, FNC16, FNC16-FNE16, GBS11, GBS15, BEC11, BEC15, BEC11-SEC11, BEC15-SEC15, ELB11, FIC11, FIC15, GBM11, HRM11, MKG11 and MKG11-RSM11 (B1 to B6 intakes) are required to take ACCT2003 Business Law as one of their DE courses, thus other course(s) with discipline in "Law" will not be classified as their DE course(s).

- ◆ In order to graduate, it is **COMPULSORY for GBM17, GBM20 and GBM22 students to participate in the outgoing exchange programme for AT LEAST one semester.**
