UNIVERSITY OF MACAU SUCCESSFULLY HELD A SHARING SESSION FOR THE DBA AND THE EMBA PROGRAMMES IN SHENZHEN

澳大DBA及EMBA學位課程深圳招生分享會成功舉辦

On 23 February 2025, the University of Macau successfully held a sharing session for the Doctor of Business Administration (DBA) and the Executive Master of Business Administration (EMBA) programmes in Shenzhen. The event aimed to provide prospective applicants with an in-depth understanding of the programme's features and development opportunities. The event attracted nearly 60 experienced entrepreneurs and senior executives from across the country, including many attendees recommended by current students.

分享會上,澳大副校長(學術)許敬文教授介紹了澳大的歷史沿革和發展概況。他提及澳大深合區校區的發展,該 校區將佈局與校本部優勢互補、相互支撐的學科,重點培養更多醫學、微電子、創意設計、金融科技和新工科等優 秀人才。這些發展無疑為學員提供了極具價值的機會,使他們能夠接觸到前沿的學術資源和行業趨勢,從而提升自 身的競爭力。



隨後,工商管理學院院長**余俊教授**對主講嘉賓進行了介紹。陳志輝教授是亞太區頂尖的市場戰略權威,專研管理策 略和市場學,對中國市場特別有研究,以及湛家揚教授在技術創新方面的重要影響。



數據及人工智能素養協會創會主席湛家揚教授則以「AI賦能可持續發展」為題,專注於人工智能在可持續發展中的 應用。他闡述了AI如何提高企業效率及減少資源浪費,並預測未來挑戰。他強調AI在應對氣候變化、城市管理和廢物 管理等方面的潛力,並分享了成功案例,展示了利用AI達成可持續發展的可能性。

其後,DBA課程主任**傅曉青教授**和EMBA課程主任**袁嘉教授**分別對各自課程進行了詳細介紹,強調了課程的獨特優勢 及未來發展方向。



此外,幾位校友代表分享了他們的求學經歷,包括DBA的李治平博士、葛良娣女士、劉青玉先生,以及EMBA的馬列 一先生、王開權先生和伊凱先生,分享了在澳大的學習收穫和職業發展,讓在場的參與者倍感鼓舞。

此次活動不僅為參加者提供了深入了解澳門大學DBA及EMBA學位課程的機會,也促進了業界精英之間的交流與合作。最後,部分與會代表參觀了華大BGI--生命科技領域的龍頭企業。在參觀過程中,大家深刻感受到了生命科技的 神奇魅力以及堅毅創新的企業家精神!

Human Mobility and Commercial Real Estate: Evidence from REIT Operating Performance

Abstract the pandemic caused a structural shift in the ways we work and live. Particularly, remote work pract banged in a more permanent manner. This study reveals how human mobility change, which potentially become a significant factor affecting the real estate market since the pandemic, affects commercial real es-performance. We first use a machine learning model (LASSD) to determine the local factors that best pre-turnan mobility change. We next analyse the impact of mobility change based on local factors on the oper-pertor lower rental revenue, lower net operating income (NOI), and lower adjusted fands from operat-pertor lower rental revenue, lower afters filter site most apparent in the office and retail sectors. We fur demonstrate human mobility neduction effects is most apparent in the office and retail sectors. We fur mobility has led to negative reactions in the stock market, particularly for office properties.
