Please read before Pre-enrollment

A) Year-4 and graduating students must complete the self-graduation check before pre-enrollment and course add/drop.

Please download the study plan from the FBA homepage and perform regular checks (<https://fba.um.edu.mo/students/study-plans/>). Please ensure you have completed **all required courses** for graduation in your final year of study.

If you have NOT taken and passed all required courses in your curriculum, you will NOT be able to graduate. In addition, a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 is required for graduation.

B) Quotas for compulsory courses and required electives

Please check your study plan on the FBA homepage (<https://fba.um.edu.mo/students/study-plans/>) before pre-enrollment and course add/drop to ensure you have enrolled in the correct courses. **Please make sure you have enrolled into all your compulsory courses and required electives.**

C) Study load

NO FBA STUDENT WILL BE ALLOWED TO TAKE EIGHT 3-CREDIT COURSES.

D) Course/Major information

GENERAL EDUCATION (GE) COURSES:

- Students admitted in and after academic year 2025/2026 (C5 and after intakes) are required to take TWO courses from EACH of the four GE areas, including ONE compulsory course from EACH area as stated below. Additional GE courses taken will **ONLY** be counted as free electives (FE). For further details, please refer to the Registry homepage (<https://reg.um.edu.mo/current-students/curriculum-model/ug-curriculum-model/general-education/2017-2018/framework/>).**

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2. **Students admitted between academic years 2017/2018 and 2024/2025 (B7 to C4 intakes)** are required to take **TWO** courses from **EACH** of the four **GE** areas, including **ONE compulsory course from EACH area** as stated below. Additional GE courses taken will **ONLY** be counted as free electives (FE). For further details, please refer to the Registry homepage (<https://reg.um.edu.mo/current-students/curriculum-model/ug-curriculum-model/general-education/2017-2018/framework/>).

3. IIR17 students (B7 and B8 intakes) are required to take PSYC1000 Introduction to Psychology. These students are **NOT** allowed to take GESB1010 Psychology of Everyday Life to fulfill either the GE or FE requirement.

ACCOUNTING (ACCT) COURSES / MAJOR:

1. ACCT2004 Intermediate Accounting is **NOT** for ACC17 and ACC19 students (B7 to C0 intakes). Those students should take ACCT2001 Intermediate Accounting I, ACCT3000 Intermediate Accounting II and ACCT3003 Intermediate Accounting III instead.
2. The pre-requisite requirement for the course below is revised starting from academic year 2025/2026.

3. ACCT3006/3007 Internship for Accounting Function I/II, which carry 1.50 credit units each, are paired required electives for ACC17-PAC17, ACC19 and ACC21 students (B7 and after intakes). Students intend to take these courses should submit the completed "Internship Acceptance Form" (FBA/Form/059) on semester basis and obtain approval from concerning course instructor **before starting the internship/enrollment**. Students should drop this course during the course add/drop period if they are **UNABLE** to find an internship successfully. 4. Graduates of the Bachelor of Science in Accounting (ACC) programme are awarded exemptions for papers by some international professional accountancy bodies, provided that the



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corresponding UM courses are completed. Please refer to FBA homepage for details (<https://fba.um.edu.mo/programmes/bachelor/bscacc/>).

5. Students should follow the study plan according to their major and intake. **NOT all ACCT courses are offered every semester**. If students do not take courses in the correct sequence, they may **NOT** graduate on time. It is recommended to **always check and fulfill the pre-requisite requirements before enrollment**. For the study plans, please refer to the FBA homepage (<https://fba.um.edu.mo/students/study-plans/>).

BUSINESS ECONOMICS (BECO) COURSES / MAJOR:

1. Students are **NOT** allowed to take BECO1000 Principles of Microeconomics and BECO1001 Principles of Macroeconomics at the same time.
2. Students **MUST** complete BECO1000 Principles of Microeconomics **before** enrolling in BECO1001 Principles of Macroeconomics.
3. BECO2000 Intermediate Economics is for GBS17, GBS20 (C1 and before intakes), FNC and FNC-FNE students only.
4. BECO2001 Econometrics I is for GBS17, GBS20 (C1 and before intakes), FNC and FNC-FNE students only.
5. BECO3008 Intermediate Microeconomics is for GBS17, GBS20 (C1 and before intakes), BEC and BEC-SEC students only.
6. BECO4003 Introduction to Econometrics is for GBS17, GBS20 (C1 and before intakes), BEC and BEC-SEC students only.
7. **IMPORTANT:** If a course is offered in the 2nd semester, normally it will NOT be offered in the 1st semester of the following academic year, with the exception of BECO1000 and BECO1001. A course will **NOT be re-offered in the next semester** even if students need it to graduate.
8. BEC and BEC-SEC students should carefully perform graduation check before pre-enrollment and course add/drop to ensure they can complete all required courses for graduation.

FINANCE (FINC) COURSES / MAJOR:

1. FINC2000 Financial Management and FINC2001 Advanced Financial Management are **NOT** for FNC17 and FNC20 students (B7 and after intakes), they should take FINC2003 Corporate Finance instead.
2. FINC2003 Corporate Finance is for FNC17 and FNC20 students (B7 and after intakes) only.
3. As a special arrangement for academic year 2026/2027, one section of FINC3001 Financial Statement Analysis and Valuation will be offered in each semester of this academic year.
4. FINC4009 Financial Modeling is for GBS17, GBS20 (C1 and before intakes), FNC17 and FNC20 (B7 to C3 intakes) students only.



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5. FINC4011 Graduation Project on Applied Finance is a two-semester course for FNC and FNC-FNE students only. Students **MUST** stay in UM to complete this one-year applied research project in their 4th year of study. Year-4 students should ensure they enroll in this course in the 1st semester of academic year 2026/2027. **Failure to take the course in the 1st semester will delay graduation.** Students wishing to participate in an overseas exchange programme should do so in their 2nd or 3rd year of study.
6. FINC4012 Financial Risk Management is for GBS17, GBS20 (C1 and before intakes), FNC and FNC-FNE students only.
7. **IMPORTANT:** If a course is offered in the 2nd semester, normally it will **NOT** be offered in the 1st semester of the following academic year. A course will **NOT** be re-offered in the next semester even if students need it to graduate.
8. FNC and FNC-FNE students should carefully perform graduation check before pre-enrollment and course add/drop to ensure they can complete all required courses for graduation.

INTERNATIONAL INTEGRATED RESORT MANAGEMENT (IRTM) COURSES / MAJOR:

1. IIR students **MUST** enroll in courses and follow the study plan according to their intake. For the study plans, please refer to the FBA homepage (<https://fba.um.edu.mo/students/study-plans/>).
2. IIR20 students **MUST** enroll in **ONE** required elective (RE) from the “*Common Required Electives List*”, and **ONE** RE from the “*Convention & Hospitality Management Required Electives List*” (for CHM20) OR the “*Gaming Management Required Electives List*” (for GMM20). Please refer to the study plans (<https://fba.um.edu.mo/students/study-plans/>) for details.
3. IRTM4009 Special Topics in Hotel and Resort Management will be offered in the 1st semester of academic year 2026/2027, and the topic will **focus on artificial intelligence applications in integrated resorts.**
4. The following courses will **ONLY** be offered in the 1st semester of academic year 2026/2027.
 - *IRTM3003 Casino Management*
 - *IRTM3004 The Macao Gaming and Hospitality Industries*
 - *IRTM3006 Human Resource Management in Integrated Resort*
 - *IRTM3009 Food and Beverage Management*
 - *IRTM3014 Hospitality and Tourism Law*
 - *IRTM3016 Casino Marketing*
 - *IRTM3017 Accommodation, Facilities and Security Management*
 - *IRTM4001 Resort Marketing and Promotion*

INFORMATION SYSTEMS AND OPERATIONS MANAGEMENT (ISOM) COURSES:

1. ISOM2001 Information Systems and Organizations will **NOT** be offered from academic year



2025/2026.

- ISOM3018 Business Data Mining and Visualization is a compulsory course for BIA19 and BIA25 students (B9 and after intakes) and is incompatible with ISOM3006 Big Data with Business Applications due to course similarity. Both ISOM3006 and ISOM3018 are **NOT** for FST students.
- ISOM3025 Business Modeling and Simulation will **NOT** be offered in the 1st semester of academic year 2026/2027. Please consider to add ISOM3037 Internet of Things and Cloud Computing with Business Applications as required elective during add/drop period.
- Only 3 credit units will be granted if students complete incompatible courses under the same group in the following table. Please note that courses in the same group are **NOT** necessarily equivalent.

GLOBAL BUSINESS MANAGEMENT (MGMT) COURSES / MAJOR:

- MGMT3000 Global Business Environment is offered to GBS22, GBM22 and MKG22 students (C4 intake), as well as all retaking students in the 1st semester.
- MGMT3001 International Management and MGMT3002 Competitive Advantage are offered to GBM22 students (C3 intake) in the 1st semester. These courses will **ONLY** be available in the 1st semester of academic year 2026/2027.
- GBM20 (C0 and C1 intakes) and GBM22 (C2 and after intakes) students need to take **two** required electives to fulfill their graduation requirements.



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4. Students should follow the study plan on FBA homepage (<https://fba.um.edu.mo/students/study-plans/>) by taking the compulsory courses and required electives each semester according to their major and intake. Otherwise, they may **NOT** graduate on time by taking incorrect course(s).

MANAGEMENT (MGMT) COURSES / MAJOR:

1. MGMT1000 Principles of Business Management is offered to ACC21 and GBS22 students (C6 intake), as well as all retaking students.
2. MGMT2000 Business Communications is offered to GBS22 students (C5 intake), and all retaking students.
3. GBS22 students (C5 intake) who take MGMT2001 Organizational Behavior in the 1st semester will take ISOM1005 Introduction to Business Intelligence and Information in the 2nd semester, and vice versa.
4. MGMT3003 Strategic Management is offered to students from ACC21 (C3 intake), FNC20, FIC22, GBM22 and MKG22 and (C4 intake), as well as all retaking students.
5. MGMT3004 Research Methods is offered to GBM22 and HRM22 students (C4 intake), as well as all retaking students.
6. MGMT3005 Human Resource Management is offered to HRM22 students (C4 intake), and all retaking students.
7. MGMT3009 Business Ethics and Corporate Social Responsibility is offered to ACC21, BEC22, and HRM22 students (C4 intake), as well as GBM22 students (C3 intake).
8. MGMT4009 Training and Development is offered to HRM22 students (C4 intake), and all retaking students.
9. MGMT4010 Performance and Compensation Management is offered to HRM22 students (C3 intake), and all retaking students. This course will **ONLY** be offered in the 1st semester of academic year 2026/2027.
10. HRM20 (C0 and C1 intakes) and HRM22 (C2 and after intakes) students need to take **three** required electives to fulfill their graduation requirements.
11. Students should follow the study plan on FBA homepage (<https://fba.um.edu.mo/students/study-plans/>) by taking the compulsory courses and required electives each semester according to their major and intake. Otherwise, they may **NOT** graduate on time by taking incorrect course(s).

MARKETING (MKTG) COURSES / MAJOR:

1. MKTG2000 Principles of Marketing is offered to GBS22 students (C5 intake), and all retaking students.
2. MKTG3000 Consumer Behavior is offered to MKG22 students (C4 intake), and all retaking students.
3. MKTG4001 Integrated Marketing Communications and MKTG4002 Marketing Strategy are



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offered to MKG22 students (C3 intake), and all retaking students. These courses will **ONLY** be available in the 1st semester of academic year 2026/2027.

4. MKG20 (C0 and C1 intakes) and MKG22 students (C2 and after intakes) need to take **three** required electives to fulfill their graduation requirements.
5. To avoid delay in graduation, MKG students should:
 - (a) Complete all compulsory courses, except ISOM4006 Project and Quality Management, by the 1st semester of their 4th year of study; and
 - (b) Follow the study plan on FBA homepage (<https://fba.um.edu.mo/students/study-plans/>) by taking the compulsory courses and required electives each semester according to their intake.

E) PROGRAMME INFORMATION

BACHELOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (BBA/GBS):

- ◆ Students are **HIGHLY RECOMMENDED** to perform the self-graduation check before pre-enrollment and course add/drop to clearly identify any missing courses.
- ◆ GBS22 students (C2 and after intakes) who have taken either ISOM1005 or MGMT2001 in the 1st semester, should take the remaining course in the 2nd semester.
- ◆ FIC22 students (C2 and after intakes) should take ACCT3009 Financial Statement Analysis in the 2nd semester of their 4th year of study.
- ◆ In order to graduate, it is **COMPULSORY for GBM17, GBM20 and GBM22 students to participate in the outgoing exchange programme for AT LEAST one semester.**
